Then as I got to know her for myself, I understood exactly who she was and I understood why our students loved and respected her. It was because of that mother's love. Her love didn't just stop at her own children. It extended to all of the children that were under her care. It even extended to me. She would wish me well and pray for me too. And for that Mother's love I am appreciative of her.

The world loss a bright light with her passing. But the love that she instilled in all of those around her should act as fuel for us to shine a little brighter to try to make up for her loss.
