Jose was a wonderful son, brother, uncle, cousin, father, grandfather and husband. He had a servant's heart and was always willing to lend a hand and never wanted to be a burden. It is an honor to know Jose and have the opportunity to have him in one's life. He is truly an inspiration and testimony to the goodness of God. It is only God that gave him the strength to endure the challenges of battling Multiple Myeloma.

The family is so grateful to know that he is now completely free of pain, completely healed and spending eternity with Jesus! 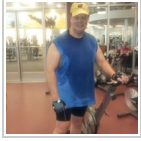
