She worked a number of years in different places in Texas, but her 14 years of sterling service to Texas Department of Health and Human Services climaxed her working contribution to society.

They later married and enjoyed approximately 12 years of marital bliss.

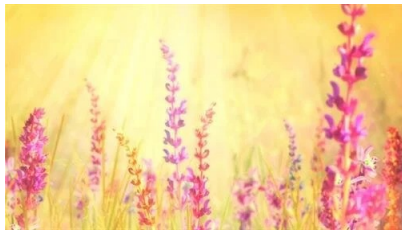
