His journey began in Clinton Park, where his early years were spent in the nurturing environments of Clinton Park Elementary School, Furr Junior High School, and Furr Senior High School.

Growing up in a large family, Kevin embraced his role as the youngest, often reminding his siblings with a twinkle in his eye that he was the "baby" of the family. He proudly wore the self-proclaimed title of his grandmother's favorite child, a testament to the special bond they shared. His grandfather fondly remembered him as the little sandy-haired, precocious child. Kevin's penchant for pranks and his innate comedic talent brought endless joy and laughter to those around him.
