“ Theodore Harris served as a loader on a Quad Fifty Machine Gun Mount of which I acted as Section Chief. We entered the City of Hue, Vietnam on the morning of 31 January 1968 in support of two Marine Companies. It was the first day of the TET Offensive. Through the course of the day we expended some 20,000 .50 Caliber rounds at the enemy and their emplacements. "The" served with bravery and professionalism, he was awarded a Bronze Star with "V" device for Valor. I have talked to Theodore many times over the years and I will miss hearing him say "Hey Sarge!" I have talked to the Marines of Golf 2/5 and Alpha 1/1 and they have said that there would have been fewer of them around today if it would not have been for our actions that day. My thoughts and prayers are with his family. I only learned of his passing this morning or I would have been there.
